Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs



If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> Most important to note are the following:

1. *Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.*
2. *Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>*

Veteran Dogs & Bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Spayed & Neutered animals may be shown. Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed Competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog competed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT – Award of Merit will be awarded after Best of Breed judging is completed for Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs in the Best of Breed competition that exemplify the breed's characteristics. These awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. The dogs selected for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible for an award of merit. At the judge's discretion, up to six (6) awards of merit for National Specialty and up to four (4) awards of merit for Independent Specialty will be awarded in the Best of Breed competition, which shall include move-ups, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and first place in Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch classes.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR PUPPY CLASS – The first-place winners from the individual Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 mos and 9-12 mos) and Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Classes will compete for the award of Best Puppy in the Regular Classes. Best Puppy competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR IN BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASSES – The first-place winners from the individual Bred-by-Exhibitor Classes (puppy and adult, both sexes) will compete for the award of Best Bred-by-Exhibitor. Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

BEST VETERAN IN THE VETERAN CLASSES – The First-place winners from the Veteran Classes will compete for the award of Best Veteran and Best of Opposite Veteran. Best Veteran competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

POINTS FOR RESERVE - NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY

The Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of America, Inc., will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch if the Regular Class Dog/Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

When making entries in the Multiple Dog Entry Classes, please indicate on the entry forms as to which dog(s) are to make up the entry in each Brace, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, or Generations Classes. If there is to be more than one Brace, please indicate "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc. **All dogs competing in these Non-Regular Classes must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular class or Best of Breed competition.** As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and a minimum of two (2); maximum of four (4) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another Class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Note - Chapter 11, Section 8, of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, provides neutered dogs may be entered as the Stud Dog.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get where appropriate.

NOTE: A castrated male may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

BRACE CLASS – Full particulars for each dog entered must be given on individual Official AKC Entry Forms. Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. Entrants must supply the registration number of all dogs in their unit. No entry will be accepted without the registration numbers of their unit members.

ENTRANTS IN GENERATION CLASS OR BREEDER'S CLASS - Dogs comprising a Generation or Breeders Class Unit must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. Each Entrant must be submitted on an official AKC entry blank. Each entrant must also supply the registration number of all dogs in their unit. No entry will be accepted without the registration numbers of their unit members. If any one of the dogs named in a unit is not entered in the show, the Unit will be rejected.

GENERATION CLASS – Three dogs with one exhibit from each generation of a three generation pedigree regardless of sex, exhibited from oldest to youngest. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible. Ownership does not need to be identical. Dog #1 - Father or Mother; Dog #2 - Son or Daughter; Dog #3 Grandson or Granddaughter of Dog #1 and Son or Daughter of Dog #2.

BREEDER'S CLASS - The breeder of record enters a team with a minimum of three and a maximum of five dogs, without distinction as to gender. The entrant must be the breeder of record for all exhibits. It is not required that the breeder of record be the current owner. All dogs entered must be a minimum of 6 months of age - spayed and neutered dogs are eligible. The team that is exhibited in the Breeder's Class must represent more than one litter and cannot all have identical parentage. Each team will be judged as a unit, standing, and moving to determine their overall quality, consistency and similarity, breed type, and conformation to the breed standard. Awards will be presented to Best Breeder's Team and Reserve Best Breeder's Team.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

OFFICIAL NOTICE: SUBSTITUTION OF JUDGES – Reference Chapter 7, Section 8 of AKC Rules: Owner has the right to withdraw his entry and have his entry fee refunded provided notification of his withdrawal is received no later than one half-hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging.

Prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Event Secretary advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No award will be mailed. If a trophy listed is unavailable, a trophy of equal or greater value will be awarded.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – NATIONAL ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
 - **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
 - **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.
- BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

NOTICE: JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY AND JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

Junior Handlers entered in a Junior Showmanship Class at the National Specialty will be allowed to enter conformation classes with the same dog at the National Specialty at NO FEE.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS. AKC Revised 5/11/18*



SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

The Sweepstakes are open to all Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs and bitches that are at least 6 months old, but not more than 18 months old on the day of the show. Entry shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Professional Handlers will not be allowed to exhibit any dog they do not own or co-own. Champions of record are ineligible to compete.

Veteran Sweepstakes are open to all Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs and bitches that are 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. Dogs do not have to be entered in a regular class. Veteran Sweepstakes Class and age division must be indicated on the entry form. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Professional Handlers will not be allowed to exhibit any dog they do not own or co-own.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.

FUTURITY & MATURITY STAKES

Professional Handlers will not be allowed to exhibit any dog they do not own or co-own.

ENTRY FOR FUTURITY STAKE JUDGING

- A. Puppies are eligible only for the Futurity Stake which occurs in conjunction with the first GSMDCA National Specialty Show held on or after the date that they reach six (6) months of age and are not eligible for subsequent Futurity Stake judging. Champions of Record are eligible to compete.
- B. Futurity entrants must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the GSMDCA National Specialty Show. The fee for this class must be paid.
- C. Futurity Stake entry form must be indicated as an additional entry of the official AKC entry form.

DIVISION OF CLASSES

Futurity Stake shall be divided into four age classifications:

- 1. 6 months and under 9 months, Puppy
- 2. 9 months and under 12 months, Puppy
- 3. 12 months and under 15 months, Junior
- 4. Over 15 months, Junior

DIVISION OF TOTAL FUTURITY STAKE MONIES

Total Futurity Stake monies shall first be divided as follows: 1. 25% to Futurity Stake Operating Expense Fund. 2. 75% to be divided between the Futurity winners.

ENTRY FOR MATURITY STAKE JUDGING

- A. Puppies are eligible for the Maturity Stake which occurs in conjunction with the second GSMDCA National Specialty Show held on or after the date of that they reach six (6) months of age and are not eligible for subsequent Maturity Stake judging. Champions of record are eligible to compete.
- B. Maturity entrants must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the GSMDCA National Specialty Show. The fee for this class must be paid.
- C. Maturity Stake entry must be indicated as an additional entry on the official AKC entry form.

DIVISION OF CLASSES

Maturity Stake shall be divided into two age classifications:

- 1. Under 24 months, Junior
- 2. Over 24 months, Senior

DIVISION OF TOTAL MATURITY STAKE MONIES

Total Maturity Stake monies shall first be divided as follows: 1. 25% to Maturity Stake Operating Expense Fund. 2. 75% to be divided between the Maturity winners as specified in the Maturity rules.

What is the Top Twenty Competition?

The Top Twenty Competition is meant to be a showcase of the top dogs from the previous year. It offers the dogs a chance to enter the ring on equal footing, to be judged on their conformity to the breed standard, not just by one outstanding virtue, and not by their popularity. Entry is by invitation only and is sent to the top 20 Swissys in breed points, as determined by American Kennel Club statistics from January 1st through December 31st of the previous year.

The Top 20 event offers all who attend a chance to view the cream of the crop in competitive standings from the previous year. This format of judging allows all eligible dogs to be equal when they step in the ring. By using three judges you will get a more concise and detailed opinion for each dog. This discourages fault judging and puts more emphasis on individual qualities and how closely each dog conforms to the breed standard. The dogs are judged by the sum of all parts, not just by one outstanding virtue. The method of scoring used limits over-faulting or over-emphasizing of specific virtues.

The three-judge panel will simultaneously judge each entrant using a predetermined system of points enumerating criteria of our breed standard. The dog receiving the highest number of points will be the panel's winner of the Top Twenty Competition. Points will not be seen or tabulated until the day the winner is announced. An impartial panel will be selected to tabulate scores, and the resulting winner will be announced at the Annual Awards Banquet.

Exclusive Top Twenty Catalog

There will be an exclusive full-color catalog for the Top Twenty Competition. Each dog entered will have a two page spread in the catalog including a pedigree, a picture, owner comments about the dog and title/health information as supplied by the owner/agent of the dog. Each entrant will receive a catalog the night of the event.
